Today’s Message: Believing the Lord Jesus Christ as Your Prophet by Winning in Total Prosperity

SUBJECT: PROSPERING WITH A CHRIST MINDSET IN PRAYER-Pt. 3

As followers of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, it is important to note: that all God is; and all that God has; may be received through prayer. For everything we need to fulfill our purpose on earth is available to us through prayer. Therefore prayer is heaven’s permission to interfere in earth’s situations.

See Psalms 115:16

Of all the things Jesus disciples observed Him say and do, the Bible records only one thing they ever asked Him to teach them, and that was; how to pray. **See Luke 11:1.** They saw Him heal; perform miracles, cast out demons, feed the multitudes, calm the storms, raise the dead, and walk on water. But they did not ask him to teach them how to do the “Spectacular” or the “Supernatural”; but they were more interested in the “Spiritual.” Why? Because, the disciples saw Jesus pray more than anything else. Therefore prayer is never wasted time, but an investment toward your future.

Pt. 2.-The Model Prayer: Hallowed Be Your Name-See Luke 11:2

The word “Hallow” means that which is holy. To be holy means to set apart in purity, consecration, and dedication for service. When Jesus says “Hallow Be Your Name”, he is stating that our Heavenly Father, who is our source and sustainer, has a name which is sacred and sanctified. Therefore God’s name will be treated with honor and reverence.

As believers there are three (3) ways in which we can Hallow The Name of the Lord

1. By remembering what the Names of God mean and what they represent. The word “name” is not a title, but a reference to His character, identity, attributes, and personality. **See Exodus 3:1-5; 14.** There are many Names of God and each expressed something specific about His love, His wisdom, and His power.
2. By doing what he instructs us regarding His Name.
 - (1) We remember His Name. **See Psalms 20:7-8.**
 - (2) We put our trust His Name. **See Psalms 33:21.**
 - (3) We bless His Name. **See Psalms 45:21.**
3. By dedicating our lives to Him because we do not want to disappoint or hurt Him. Because He is holy, His name is to be manifested to all people. **See John 17:6.**

- (1) Holy in our Actions-our hands, our feet, and our entire body is holy. We bring glory and honor to God in the way we conduct ourselves.
- (2) Holy in our Words-our mouths will be used to praise God; to speak about spiritual things; and to tell others about word of God, the will of God, and the ways of God.
- (3) Holy in our Thoughts-our thoughts and our minds will be used to think about what is lovely, what is pure, what is right, what is honest, and what is excellent about Gods Name and revelation.
- (4) Holy in our Emotions-we love the things that God loves, and we will be gentle, patient, and kind to others. We will not worry about anything, but pray about everything.
- (5) Holy in our Desires-our desires is not be a “Man-pleaser” but a “God pleaser”; by seeking first the Kingdom of God.

Five (5) Confessions regarding “Hallowing” The Name of The Lord

1. I confess that I have the mindset of Christ in prayer; I have everything that I need to fulfill my purpose on earth; and it is made available through prayer.
2. I confess that I will “Hallow” Your Name by remembering what the names of the Lord means and what they represent.
3. I confess that I will “Hallow” Your Name by doing what You instructs me regarding Your Name.
4. I confess that I will “Hallow” Your Name by dedicating my life to You. I dedicate my life to You, through my actions, my words, my thoughts, my emotions, and my desires.
5. I confess that I will “Hallow” Your Name. You are a Holy God.
