SUBJECT: PROSPERING WITH A CHRIST MINDSET IN PRAYER-Pt. 4

As followers of our Lord Jesus Christ is important to note; that all God is; and all that God has; may be received through prayer. For everything we need to fulfill our purpose on earth is available to us through prayer. Therefore prayer is heaven’s permission to interfere in earth’s situations. **See Psalms 115:16.**

Of all the things Jesus disciples observed Him say and do, the Bible records only one thing they ever asked Him to teach them, and that was how to pray. **See Luke 11:1.** They saw him heal; perform miracles, cast out demons, feed the multitudes, calm the storms, raise the dead, and walk and water. But they did not ask him to teach them how to do the “Spectacular” but they were more interested in the “Spiritual”. Why? Because, the disciples saw Jesus pray more than anything else. Therefore prayer is never wasted time.

Pt. 3 The Model Prayer Your Kingdom Come-See Luke 11:2

Introduction: “Our Father which is in Heaven”-God is our Source and Sustainer. “Holy Be Your Name”-God is Sacred and is Sanctified. **Today’s Message-“Your Kingdom Come”-God is Sovereign.**

The word “Kingdom” in the original language means to “rule” or to “reign. God’s kingdom is unique-for it is not a human kingdom. Earthly kingdoms rise and fall, but the reign of God will prevail and last forever. When Jesus says “Your Kingdom Come”; he desires that we ask God to advance and expand the kingdom in the hearts of people, and we are anticipating a day when the kingdom people literally comes and Jesus Christ returns upon the earth. It is a kingdom that is both present and future-it is here and now, and will one come in the fullness. Jesus first sermon consisted of a “Kingdom” message. **See Mark 1:14-15.**

“Thy Kingdom Come” is a (3) three-fold Prayer

- 1. An Exalting Prayer-**In the “Kingdom”; there is a King who rules and reign over his people. In addition, he has a domain which is his dominion, a government, a territory, and a system. **See Matthew 6:33.**
- 2. An Equipping Prayer-**In the “Kingdom”; emphasis is placed on those on those essentials qualities which are necessary for living a successful and significant life. **See Romans 14:17.**
- 3. An Evangelizing Prayer-**In the “Kingdom” people are translated from darkness to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. **See Colossians 1:13-14.**

As believers, it is so assuring to know that in end, at the 7th and last trumpet, the Kingdom of God will reign and rule forever throughout eternity. **See Revelation 11:15.**

Six (6) Confessions regarding the Kingdom of God Principles and Prayers

1. I confess; I have the mindset of Jesus Christ in prayer.
2. I confess; everything I need to fulfill my purpose on earth can be made available through prayer.
3. I confess; "Your Kingdom Come" is an Exalting Prayer in which You God as my king rule and reign over my life with your dominion, government, territory, and system.
4. I confess; "Your Kingdom Come" is an Equipping Prayer in which I possess righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.
5. I confess; "Your Kingdom Come" is an Evangelizing Prayer in which I have been rescued from a life of darkness and now I live a life based on Jesus love for me.
6. I confess: "Your Kingdom" will rule and reign forever.
